As you may be aware, our planning for development of the building on Prospect Avenue as our 4 class building, was refused by Mayo Co Council at the end of the year. We appealed this decision to An Bord Pleanala, and have just recently received their decision to uphold the Mayo Co. Council decision, and refuse planning.
