COVID 19 SYMPTOMS REMINDER

Do not send your child to school or childcare if any of the following is true.


Your child has:

- a temperature of 38 degrees Celsius or more
- a new cough
- loss or changed sense of taste or smell
- shortness of breath

If your child has symptoms such as headaches or a sore throat, keep them at home for at least 48 hours.

Keep an eye on your child's symptoms for 48 hours. After 48 hours it's usually okay to send your child back to school or childcare as long as:

- their symptoms do not get worse
- they do not develop new symptoms
- they do not need paracetamol or ibuprofen during these 48 hrs
